CRAO What Do We Do?

The Calendar Review and Analysis Office was developed to assure compliance with Medicare reporting requirements for Clinical Research. As a result the Billing Calendar (BC) was created. CRAO reviews the billing calendar for accurate items/services and time points per the protocol, consent, budget etc. to ensure all items are captured for billing purposes. This helps reduce legal consequences of non-compliant billing. CRAO addresses billing issues but **does not** perform the actual billing. We are happy to assist you with any clinical research billing issues you may have. Please complete a CRB Charge Correction Request Form and submit to CRBIssues-help@umich.edu.

CRAO also administers MBECT and provides training for staff entering billing calendars and/or enrollment into MBECT. Questions about MBECT can be directed to MBECT-help@umich.edu

Billing and Coding Corner

DID YOU PROVIDE A SERVICE THE SAME DAY OF ENROLLMENT (signing the Consent)?

What you should do to avoid billing issues...

If you enroll a subject and they receive services the same day complete an <u>Unscheduled Occurrence</u> <u>Form</u> and send high priority e-mail subject line to include: "HUM#, Same day Enrollment" to Revenue Cycle Research Billing (RCRB) at <u>Researchsubjects@med.umich.edu</u>

Please submit the same day if at all possible . Submit the completed form and all questions to Researchsubjects@med.umich.edu.

The Clinical Research Unscheduled Occurrence Form is **also** used by the study team to direct a patient's unscheduled service to the appropriate payer **prior** to the charges being processed.





Is venipuncture (specimen collect) still required on Billing Calendars now that pathology is not charging for this service?

Yes, currently Pathology is in a pilot phase of not charging for the research venipuncture. At this time we recommend that this charge be placed on the billing calendar until pathology decides to <u>permanently</u> stop charging for this service.
