Tips and Tidbits

Recently when I was in MBECT selecting Items and Services for my billing calendar I noticed #DNU in front of some of the descriptions. Can you tell me what this means?

#DNU means Do Not Use. These are from the UMHS chargemaster previous to MiChart. No action is required on your part. Calendars created before February 1, 2012 will have the #DNU numbers on the calendar. A conversion occurs once the billing calendar information is transferred from eResearch to MiChart.
